Recycle clean metal pie plates, glass jars and clean foil. Plastics 1-7 belong in the recycle bin, not the trash.

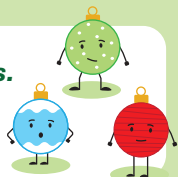


Reuse ribbon, boxes and bows. Holiday gift bags can be reused year after year.

Trash old tree decorations. Tinsel, ornaments and light strands are not recyclable.

Recycle wrapping paper and paper holiday cards. Most wrapping paper and holiday cards can be recycled with the exception of items with foil. Photo cards are not recyclable.



HOLIDAY TREE RECYCLING GUIDELINES

City of Sacramento residential yard waste customers can place trees in the street for pickup as part of the City's Leaf Season service. Leaf Season collection is November through January.

*The last day that trees or any yard waste can be placed on the street for collection is **January 27, 2019**. You can find your estimated pickup date on our Collection Calendar at www.sacrecycle.org.*

1 Trees should be clean of all lights, tinsel, tree stands, nails, and decorations.

2 Flocked trees will be accepted.

3 Not a City yard waste customer? There are free local tree drop off events on January 5 & 6. Visit Sacrecycle.org for locations and times.

4 If you miss the citywide tree collection, you can put your tree in your yard waste container. Please cut the tree in pieces that fit completely into the container with the lid closed.
